

Starting from the 1st Semester of the 2023–24 Academic Year, the English Exit Requirement for Undergraduate Programs Will Be Abolished (Announcement Date: 2023-02-15)

Starting from the 1st semester of the 2023–24 academic year (Academic Year 112), the English Exit Requirement for undergraduate programs will be abolished. However, academic departments (including degree programs) may set their own English exit requirements based on educational goals and assessment needs. Additional details are as follows:

1. Students who were required to extend their studies in the 2nd semester of the 2022–23 academic year (Academic Year 111) due to not meeting the English exit requirement must still register for the following semester. They must submit an application form for the elective course "English Proficiency Test" to the Registration and Curriculum Office within the first two weeks of the semester, and may collect the certificate after the 7th week.
2. From the 1st semester of the 2023–24 academic year (Academic Year 112), transcripts will no longer indicate whether the student has met the English exit requirement. However, this note will still be retained for students who passed in previous semesters.
3. Students in departments that set their own English exit requirements must continue to use the "English Exit Requirement Review Platform" and submit their documents online via the Student Info System. Upon departmental approval, they will be deemed to have met the department's English graduation requirement.
