1. This program is handled in accordance with the following documents (see attachments): Tunghai University and National Quemoy University Academic Exchange and Cooperation Agreement (PDF), THU Regulations for Domestic Exchange Students (PDF, Tunghai University and National Taitung University Domestic Student Exchange Agreement (PDF)
2. Exchange Duration: National Taitung University: Students may apply for

one semester or one academic year. National Quemoy University: One semester only (extensions may be granted upon mutual agreement of both universities, limited to one additional semester).

3. Eligibility:

- (1) Full-time Tunghai University students (undergraduate and graduate) who have completed at least one year of study.
- (2) Minimum average grade of 70 (GPA 2.44) in the previous academic year.

4. Required Documents:

- (1) One completed application form
- (2) One official transcript (original)
- (3) One course plan
- (4) Other relevant materials

5. Application Period: April 7 to April 18, 2025

6. Application Procedure: Applicants should obtain the application form from the Registration and Curriculum Office, submit the required documents, and obtain approval from their department chair and college dean before submitting to the Office for processing.

7. Selection Method: Review and selection will be conducted by relevant departments and the Academic Affairs Office.

8. Number of Students Admitted: National Taitung University: Up to 2 students per academic year; National Quemoy University: Up to 10 students per semester

9. Notification of Admission: Admission results will be announced by National Taitung University and National Quemoy University by mid-June and applicants will be notified by the Registration and Curriculum Office.

10. Registration and Course Selection: Exchange students must register at Tunghai University during the exchange period and take courses at the host university in accordance with its academic regulations and credit limits.

11. Credit Transfer: Credits earned during the exchange must be reviewed and approved by the relevant department and Academic Affairs Office at Tunghai University to be counted toward graduation requirements.
